Volunteer Prayer Chaplain Position Description

Maryland Family Institute envisions a Maryland where God is honored, life is cherished, families flourish and religious liberty thrives. We pursue this mission by engaging and equipping God's people to advance faith, family and freedom in Maryland's capital, church and culture. Since prayer is an integral part of this mission, MFI is seeking a volunteer Prayer Chaplain (VPC) who will organize, lead and manage our prayer efforts. Our VPC will:

- Pray for MFI friends, donors and allied organizations, along with legislators at the state and local levels. We maintain a prayer list through which we pray every week. The VPC will solicit for, organize, follow up on, and keep MFI informed about this list. The VPC will periodically call, email and text people on the prayer list to check in and receive status updates. The VPC will pray with and for these folks as a regular part of their ministry.
- Lead and participate in weekly staff prayer times
- Participate and occasionally lead our monthly Zoom prayer calls.
- Meet with the MFI President weekly to report on our prayer efforts, and to pray for him, his family and the MFI team.
- Devise a systematic approach to praying for Maryland's elected leaders County Executives & School Board Members, Delegates, Senators, the Governor, the MD Supreme Court, and our Congressmen and Senators. This person would work with an MFI graphic designer to devise a prayer resource/guide for praying for each of these levels of leaders.
- Work with outside organizations the BCMD, the National Day of Prayer, the Family Policy Alliance to coordinate and promote prayer efforts in Maryland.
